

Case Study #1 – Health Care Company

- Engaged APG to support their next generation customer service/ nurse line initiative
- Designed and delivered customized training curriculum to 40 team members
 - Unified Modeling Language (UML) for business architecture, business process modeling, and requirements management
- Developed traceability strategy including elements such as business process workflows, business rules, and business requirements
 - Extended into solution delivery lifecycle to connect with system requirements and test cases
- Worked with tool deployment team to configure modeling and requirements management tools to implement the traceability strategy
 - Created a set of reports representing key business architecture views that could be automatically generated out of the integrated tool repository
- Project was reported as only business transformation project that was deemed a success within entire corporation for that calendar year
 - Local tool vendor team also reported that they had never seen a more elegant and capable implementation of their tools



Case Study #2 – Unemployment Insurance

- Engaged APG to build a business architecture capability and lead organization in strategic business and technology transformation
- Agency wished to replace all legacy technologies
 - Acquire new package implementation that incorporated best-of-class business practices for unemployment benefits
- Scope included enterprise business services and capabilities
 - Benefits management
 - Benefits eligibility and certification
 - Claims processing and disbursement
 - Determination of monetary benefits
 - Claims adjudication
 - Inter-agency collaboration (state and federal)
 - Financial reconciliation
 - Federal and state reporting and auditing
- Provided initial *lead business architect* and project coach
 - Supported application of the newly learned skills
 - Facilitated group workshops and one-on-one mentoring/coaching sessions



Case Study #2 – Unemployment Insurance

- Designed and delivered customized training curriculum to over 60 team members
 - Unified Modeling Language (UML) for business architecture, business process modeling, and requirements management
- Designed enterprise traceability strategy and implemented in tools
 - Developed custom business architecture data warehouse to support specialized reporting requirements
- Helped team produce comprehensive business process model that was used to derive set of system requirements for future implementation
 - Automatically published RFP for procuring a package implementation
- Agency significantly out-performed sister agency that was attempting something similar
 - Delivered RFP in four months, as opposed to two years for sister agency (with three times scope)
- Supported project after RFP was awarded
 - Established governance, management, and development capabilities
 - Provided ongoing training to new team members



Case Study #3 – Global Petroleum Corporation

- Engaged APG to analyze current use of modeling tool for global project use
- Design appropriate version control integration for multiple user access
 - Configured tool for versioning and baseline use including database and elements and use of *Microsoft Team Foundation Server*
- Design proper SQL server-based repository for global remote access
 - Supports approximately 30 users from global locations
- Review and analyze existing model organization structure
 - Provided best practices for model structuring to support packages, elements and diagrams
 - Setup guidelines for restricting roles/permissions using Model Guardian concept
 - Provided details for work flow review/approval process
- Creation of RTF reports or other HTML-based reports
 - Created a set of reports representing key architecture views that could be automatically generated out of the integrated tool repository



Case Study #4 – National Insurance Company

- Engaged APG to create an enterprise architecture repository that would improve the consistency, completeness and availability of IT information used in impact analyses.
- Provide a reliable enterprise architecture repository based environment and corporate capability
 - Provided best practices for effective and optimized capabilities for an optimized and reliable enterprise architecture practice
- Design appropriate views of content in the repository for different stakeholder concerns
 - Configured tool for role based views and reports to facilitate a common understanding of the proposed architecture designs
- Reduce impact analysis time
 - Created views and reports that reduced the impact assessment time from three months to less than one month
 - Significant reduction in domain expert resources required for assessment effort
- **Demonstrate compliance** of regulatory rules
 - Created reports to more accurately verify compliance with regulatory guidelines and rules in a more timely and effective manner
